Seconded by Brian Cheston. Carried.

Sandy Lane Beach Retaining Wall - Brian Cheston spoke about how the existing beach is erosion at the Sandy Lane Beach. Concrete Jersey Barriers were to be installed two years ago by the County. Glenda will speak with County Councillor Lorne Halisky and County Bylaw Officer Ed English to request this be done asap.
